Dr. Michael Brauer is a professor in the School of Environmental Health at UBC. He is a recognized internationally for his air quality research in environmental and occupational exposure assessment, health effects, transportation, vegetation fires, indoor air pollution, air quality in Asia , and development of sampling and analysis methods for air pollutants.
