

3RD ANNUAL A&WMA VANCOUVER ISLAND CHAPTER TEXAS SCRAMBLE (“BEST BALL”) GOLF TOURNAMENT RULES

Participants are sorted into teams, each with a Captain to keep score. There is one team score per hole. Each player hits a tee shot (men use white and women use red tees) and the team selects the shot to be used. Each team member hits their next shot from within 12” of the selected ball, but no closer to the hole. When the ball lands on the green it is replaced with a ball marker and each team member putts from that position. Each player takes a turn putting until the ball is in the hole. Play moves on to the next hole.

Each team member must have three tee (first) shots and two second shots selected (counted) during the game, requiring some skillful course management. A putt may count as a second shot; therefore indicating that some thought be given to the order in which team members putt on any given hole. The Captain must keep track of each team member’s counted shots as well as the team score for each hole. Immediately following the last hole played, each Captain must hand in the team score card at the Registration desk.

The Rules of Golf will apply. Please respect out of bounds (OB) markers and hazards. If a shot goes OB or into a hazard, you may either ignore the shot or count it, taking the appropriate penalty. The lowest team score with a correctly filled out score card will be the winner. In the event of a tie, a tie breaking system has been devised by the organizing committee.

Any team member may purchase one Mulligan ticket for \$5.00. This will allow a player to re-take only one shot. Each Captain will collect the Mulligan tickets noting the redemption of each on the score card as used.

Individual Contests

Closest to the Pin	Longest Drive
Must be on the green	Must be in the fairway
Men’s hole number 11	Men’s hole is number 16
Ladies hole number 6	Ladies hole is number 8

A team is not required to select the shot for it to be counted in the individual contest. When you make a better shot than that already marked, you may move the marker and record your name on the attached sheet.

Each team member may purchase a “Gimme String” for \$5.00. If a shot ends up inside the length of the string from the flag it’s considered to be in the hole. For example, on a par three, a tee shot ending up within a string’s length from the flag would be counted as a hole in one. Strings can be added together to make the hole even bigger. A string cannot be used for the closest to the pin contest. Strings can only be used once.

The maximum score per hole is double par, 6 on a par 3, 8 on a par 4 and 10 on the par 5.
