**Management of Environmental Issues at  
BC Ferries**

Always wondered what happens below the car deck on a BC Ferry? Interested in Sewage, Bilge Water, Diesel Exhaust, Hazardous Waste...?

These are just a few of the environmental issues associated with the operation of Canada's largest domestic ferry operator. Michael will be discussing BC Ferries approach to managing a complex web of environmental issues, aging assets and complex regulatory requirements.

Michael will also be discussing what criterion BC Ferries considers in selecting consultants for environmental projects.

Since April of 2003 Michael has been working with British Columbia Ferry Services Inc. (formerly a crown corporation). Prior to working with BC Ferries, Michael was the Environmental Coordinator at Royal Roads University.

Born in Regina, Saskatchewan, Michael earned a degree in Biology in 1999 with the University of Victoria and a Bachelor of Science in Environmental Science in 2001 at Royal Roads University.
