Environmental Management Issues at the Crofton Pulp Mill -

Environmental Manager, Crofton Pulp Mill***

Mr. Kissack will be discussing environmental matters from an industry's point of view, that being issues that have faced NorskeCanada and the Crofton Pulp Mill. He will be discussing what they have learned dealing with the feedback from the application to burn alternate fuels and what issues he sees are facing larger industries in the future.
